

HEALTH & EDUCATION


- ✓ Construction of a Hospital with O.T. and educational aid to children.

Considering this reality, Department of Education & Skill Development took initiative for better career progression. We have launched 1 new branch of Gurukul.




PROJECT SAKSHAM
